SNWIB Special Summer School Session

A special summer school session will be held for SNWIB youth in English, math and math proficiency tutoring. **June 15, 2009 – July 23, 2009** at the following locations.

Morning session: 7:30 a.m. – 10 a.m. daily

Virtual High School (online courses)

CCSD Secondary Summer School (This is an option for youth who are qualified for WIA **after** the start of the six-week summer sessions listed above. They may enroll in the second session of 'regular' summer school offered July 5 – 23, 2009)

Two, three-week session, various sites and numerous course offerings

Session #2: July 6-July 23, 2009

Day classes: 7:30am – 12:00pm

Evening Classes: 4:00pm – 8:30pm

Work Experience (NOTE: Summer Work Experience would offer one-half of an elective credit per summer and may be repeated once. 120 work experience hours are to be completed within the extended summer school term, June 15 – August 14.)

The qualifications/requirements for CCSD for Summer Work Experience are:

- Submit CCSD agreement form upon enrollment: (This is in the WIA registration packet.)
CCF-742: Cooperative Occupational Education Training Agreement (upon enrollment)
- Regular monitoring by CCSD Work Experience Coordinators with employers and students to complete CCSD report
CCF-741: Employer Work Experience Report (weekly)

- Submission of time cards with a minimum of 120 hours of work
